## ANIMATION STUDENTS DIVES INTO THE REALM OF ANIMATION

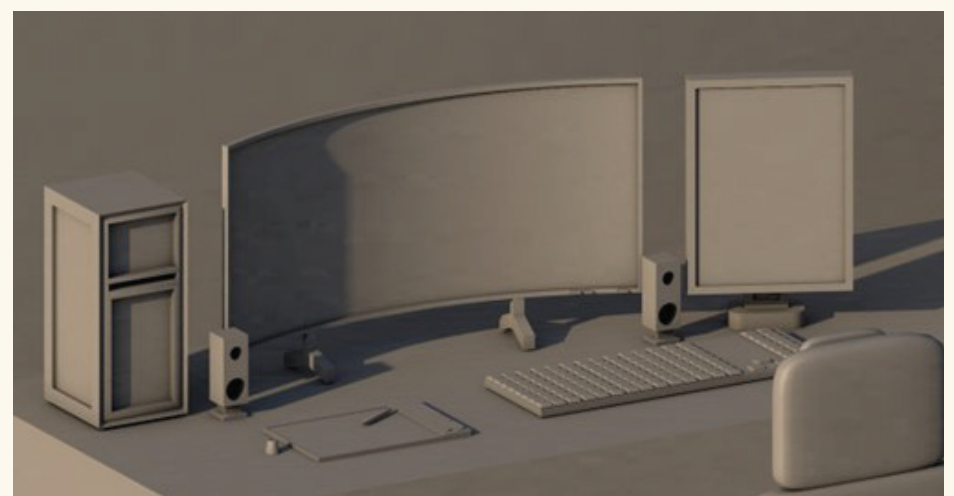
